Hoboken Police Department seeks public assistance identifying seven persons of interest in recent carjacking

The Hoboken Police Department is seeking public assistance to identify seven persons of interest, wanted in connection with a carjacking on Jan. 15, 2024.

The incident occurred at approximately 11:36 p.m., on the 600 block of Sinatra Drive, when three individuals in ski masks approached a victim and pulled him out of his car demanding his cellphone. The victim reported one individual produced a gun and hit him in the head with it, and another threatened him with a large combat style knife. The individuals took the cellphone and fled in the vehicle, which had personal property inside, including power tools and recording equipment worth a total value of approximately \$2,300. The Hoboken Volunteer Ambulance Corps arrived to treat the victim who had injuries to the head. He refused further medical attention. Responding officers located the cell phone in Hoboken while canvassing the area that night. The vehicle, a 2008 Honda Accord, was located a few days later in the Bronx and the recording equipment was found in Jersey City.

Further investigation by Detective Bret Globke and the Hoboken Detectives Bureau revealed an additional four other individuals were involved in this crime.
